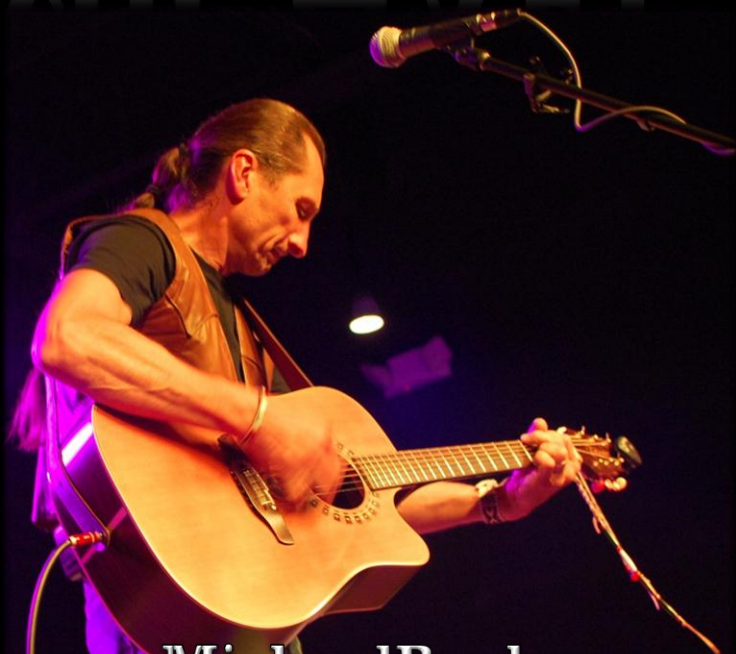


3 TIME NAMMY-WINNING MUSICIAN MICHAEL BUCHER

Since his childhood, Michael Bucher has been taught the ways of his ancestors. Asked by his late Uncle to “do something with his talent,” Bucher has made it his life’s purpose to sing about the issues that are close to his heart. Namely, to teach the world about the importance of Native sacred sites, Cherokee legends, living together peaceably and reaching out to the youth of today in order to inspire them to do great things.

Since the debut of Bucher’s first independent album, “Seven” in 2007, Bucher has continued to rack up a slew of awards every year since. Each of his next albums, to include “Bitter Tears, Sacred Ground” (part of a compilation with Grammy winner Joanne Shenandoah) in 2009 and “Believe” in 2010 have received several high-profile nominations and award wins in several categories at such popular venues as the NAMA’s and the Indian Summer Music Awards.

Bucher’s tracks have been selected to appear in award-winning documentaries and on a compilation album to combat homelessness in the U.S. His music has also received considerable airplay on nationally syndicated radio programs.

As an artist that has produced award-winning videos, has received several favorable press reviews and appears in a book as a role model for children – Michael Bucher has easily demonstrated he is a force to be considered.
